



The new breed of writers include modern literary icons such as Sally Rooney, Colm Tobin, Anne Enright Rody Doyle and Claire Keegan.



A STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE

STEP 1 — START YOUR APPLICATION

Applications can be made directly to BIMM Music Institute Dublin via the 'Apply' form on our website (bimm.ie). Applications for the BA (Hons) Commercial Modern Music course must be submitted through the CAO website (www.cao.ie/apply) using the course code TU 961.

STEP 2 — BOOK YOUR AUDITION/PORTFOLIO REVIEW

Once we've reviewed your application, our Admissions Team will be in touch to arrange an in-person or online audition or portfolio review. You'll then receive a confirmation email with the date, time and location, plus information on what to prepare. You may be able to submit a demo instead, depending on which course you've applied for.

STEP 3 — ATTEND YOUR AUDITION/INTERVIEW

In-person auditions are held on campus and are conducted by our BIMM assessors. This is your time to show us what you can do, and you'll receive important feedback on how to develop your skills. Visit our website for details on the audition format for your chosen course. Online auditions and interviews are conducted live on Zoom or remotely via email.

STEP 4 — VIEW YOUR OFFER

Direct applicants will be contacted by the university when the outcome of their application is ready with a list of next steps. Applicants who applied via CAO will be able to view their offer in the 'My Application' section website of the section.

STEP 5 — ACCEPT YOUR OFFER

CAO applicants must accept their offer via the CAO website, while direct applicants will receive instruction from BIMM on how to accept. Once you have confirmed your place, our finance department will be in touch during the summer months to confirm your method of payment for the course. You will then receive information regarding enrolment.
