Immerse yourself in London or Berlin for a year to build your creative network with our one-year CertHE courses.

If you're looking to explore a career in music, film or video games but aren't ready to commit to a full degree right now, a CertHE course could be the right path of you. 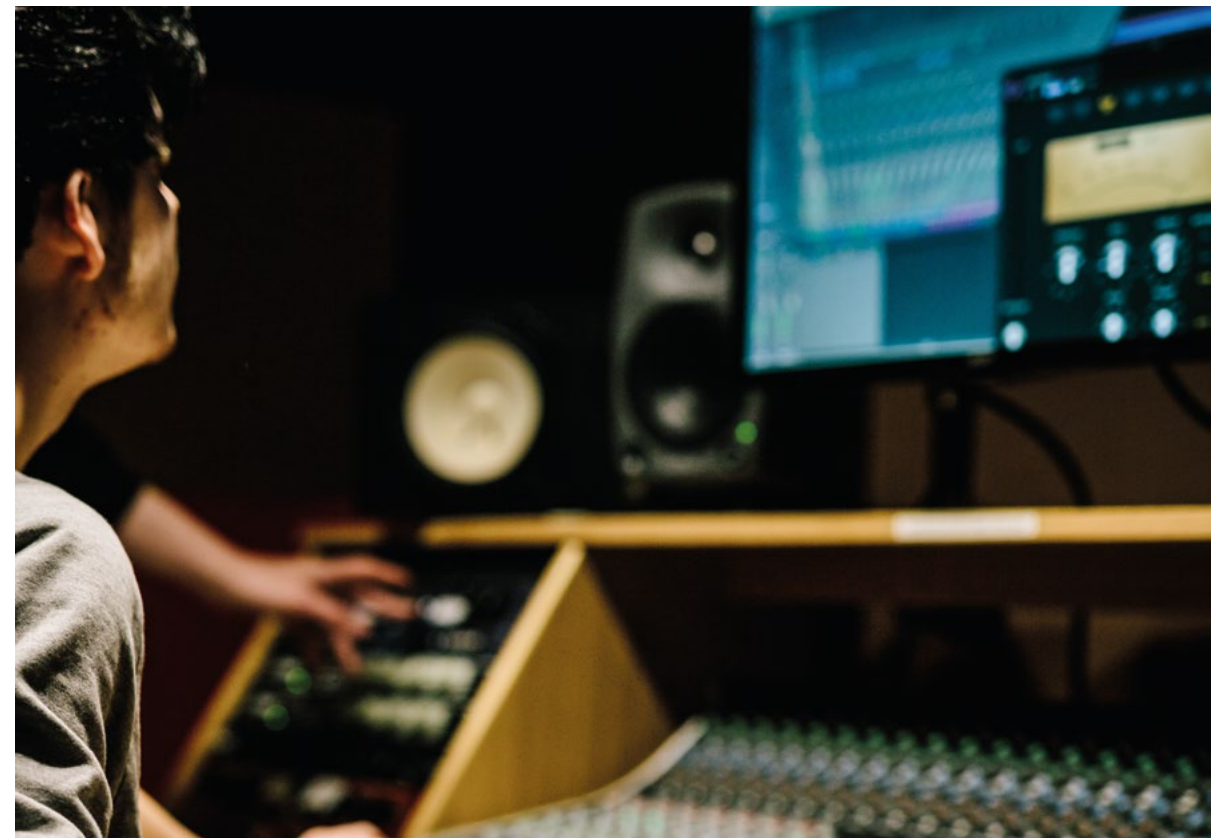

Dublin

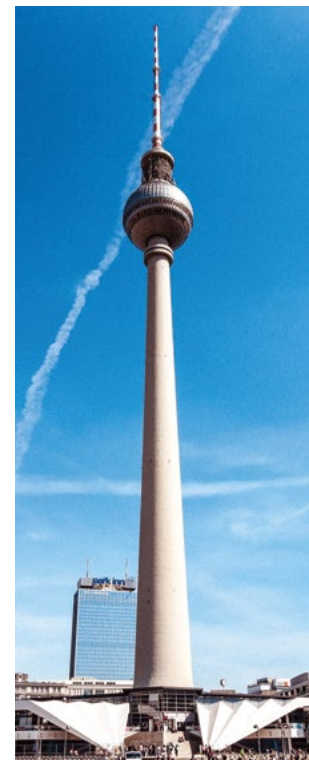
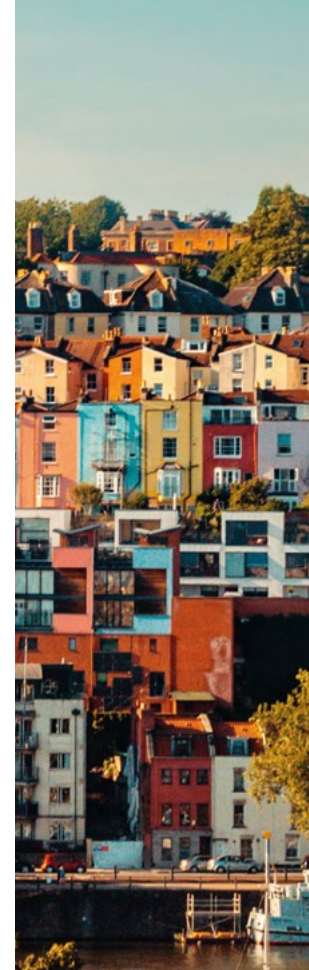

Submit your application

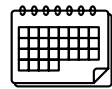

STEP 4

Complete your Interview/audition

Your interviewer will review the material you've submitted and use it to guide the conversation with you. This is your time to show us what you know and can do, as well as receive feedback on taking your skills further.



STEP 5

Accept your offer

You've submitted everything we need, smashed your interview and decided that BIMM University is the place for you. To secure your place, pay your deposit and you'll be with us in no time.
