If you are looking to start your journey into the world of video games production, this hands-on, one year qualification with provide you with the practical skills you need.





Student Associations




Applying to BIMM University

How to apply

STEP 4

Complete your Interview/audition

Your interviewer will review the material you've submitted and use it to guide the conversation with you. This is your time to show us what you know and can do, as well as receive feedback on taking your skills further.
