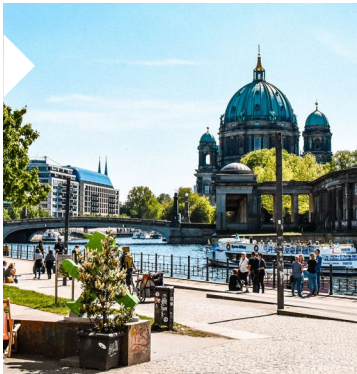
Brighton

How to apply



STEP 1 Submit your application

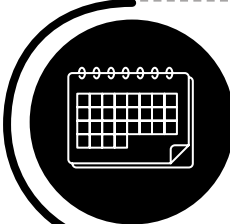
Start off by creating an account on our handy application portal. Then start the application. You'll be asked questions that help us understand you and your creative experience.

You will only need to apply once, either directly with our application form, or via UCAS for the UK schools.

Once you've submitted, our team will review your application so we can plan the next steps of your journey. You'll receive more information on what you

need to do next (including submitting any documents and completing an interview/audition) in the form of a conditional offer via email.

STEP 2 We will review your application



STEP 3 Book your audition or interview

Our Admissions Team will reach out to you to arrange an interview/audition for your chosen course.

You'll also receive information on what materials you should prepare and submit in advance.

Your interviewer will review the material you've submitted and use it to guide the conversation with you.

This is your time to show us what you know and can do, as well as receive feedback on taking your skills further.
