Berlin

Birmingham

Brighton


Manchester

Our Facilities





Thoughtfully designed to suit both new and experienced educators, this flexible and comprehensive course offers opportunities to develop your teaching skills using contemporary educational theory, and even to undertake your own research.

We take a highly person-centred approach, offering expert tuition, one-to-one mentoring, engaging practical workshops and guided independent study. By the end of your course, you can expect to be a highly creative, thoughtful and collaborative educator with the skillset to succeed in both further and higher education. This MA is offered in two distinct pathways:

The 'Initial Teacher Education' pathway, designed for early and pre-career teachers, focuses on developing practical and reflective skills within the classroom. The pathway includes a work placement that forms the ITE requirements for professional formation (QTLS) through the Education & Training Foundation.

The 'Experienced Educator' pathway is aimed at qualified teachers or those with over three years of teaching experience. In this pathway, you'll explore new practices in leadership and educational change, gaining deeper theoretical and pedagogic knowledge that will enrich your teaching.

Applying to BIMM University

All international students can apply directly to BIMM University with no application fees. Most of our courses require an audition, interview or portfolio review. Please get in touch with our International Admissions Team at admissions@bimm.ac.uk who will guide you through the application process.

Discount eligibility

To be eligible for the Early Confirmation Discount, you must:

- Be an overseas applicant ineligible for home (domestic) fees.
- Apply and receive an offer to study a BIMM University course.
- Accept your offer.
- Pay your deposit, if applicable, by the deadline specified on the website.

The discount will automatically be deducted from your fees when you enrol. This discount cannot be used in conjunction with any other discount, offer or scholarship.

Accommodation

How to apply

You've found the perfect course and you're ready to join us. Follow this step-by-step guide to start your journey at BIMM University.

Step 1: Start your application

You can apply directly to BIMM University by creating an applicant account and submitting an online application form.

Step 2: Arrange your interview

Once we have reviewed your application, our Admissions Team will be in touch to arrange your interview with a Course Leader. You'll be sent a confirmation email with the date, time and location, as well as information on what to prepare.

Step 3: Attend your interview

Your interviewer will review the material you've submitted and use it to guide the conversation. This is your time to show us what you can do, and you'll receive valuable feedback on how to take your skills further.

Step 4: Meet the conditions of your offer

Our Admissions Team will send you an offer pack and contract. All offers will be conditional until we can verify that you've met the entry requirements for the course. We will amend your offer to unconditional once we have received copies/clear photographs of your certificates.

Step 5: Accept your offer

Sign into your Applicant Portal and follow the instructions to confirm your place. Our finance department will be in touch during the summer months to confirm your method of payment for the course. You'll then receive information regarding enrolment.
