

This is your guide to making an application through UCAS for all undergraduate courses that are offered at BIMM University.

To make an application for an undergraduate course at BIMM University, you will need to submit an application through UCAS – www.ucas.com

You will need to register in the UCAS Hub to start an application.

Should you need assistance with your application, please review guides available on the UCAS Hub.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

There is an application fee for submitting a UCAS application, payable direct to UCAS: £27.50

This will allow you to add up to five course choices on your application, as well as allow access to additional services that UCAS has to offer such as Extra, Clearing and Clearing Plus.

WHAT TO INCLUDE IN YOUR UCAS APPLICATION

Academic Oualifications

Make sure to list all of your completed academic achievements and any that are pending.

If you are a mature applicant (19+) that does not hold the academic entry criteria, we can consider you for Record of Prior Practice (RPP). Guidelines will be provided should this route be available to you.

Personal Statement

You must include a personal statement with your application. You can find guides on writing a personal statement on the **UCAS website**. Please note there is a maximum of 4000 characters that can be used. Please use paragraphs within your statement as this makes it clearer to read.

Top Tip – Write your personal statement in a word document and then paste it into your UCAS application. This will allow you to check spelling and grammar.

Reference

You will need to supply a reference with your application. Ideally this should be a tutor/teacher at your school/college. If you are no longer in education and are working, please provide a reference from your employer.

Offer of a place

If your application is successful you will be made one of two offers: Conditional OR Unconditional.

A conditional offer means further information is required to meet the entry criteria for the course such as exam results/ certificates or a successful Audition/Interview/Portfolio. An unconditional offer means you have met the entry criteria for the course and not need to supply any additional information.

If you are a UK applicant, offers for undergraduate courses can only be made if you have submitted your UCAS application.. If you have not yet applied through UCAS, please do so as soon as possible. This will allow us to process your offer as quickly as possible.

You will be able to view details of your offer any conditions on your UCAS Hub. This is where you will need to confirm if you wish to accept your place.

If your application is unsuccessful, details can be viewed on your UCAS Hub.

The equal consideration deadline is the 31st January 2024 at 18:00 GMT.

Applications received by this date will be prioritised. Applications received after this date will be considered once all equal consideration deadline applicants have been reviewed. We will accept late applications until the 30th June 2024 at 18:00 GMT.
