WHAT TO EXPECT ON THE DAY

Workshops

Our workshops give you the opportunity to check out our exceptional film facilities and meet our specialist lecturers and technicians. You'll be able to ask questions, connect with other prospective students, and gain valuable insights into the industry.

Workshops typically include:

- The role of a producer
- Behind the scenes of the film business
- Creative producing

All materials and equipment will be provided.

Portfolio review

As part of the Applicant Day, you'll have an informal chat with a member of the team, where you'll present a portfolio of your work and ideas. This is your opportunity to share your creativity and career aspirations. You'll have 15 minutes for this session, so please present a small segment of your best work.

Your portfolio could include:

- Business plans or budgets
- Scriptwriting
- Film, TV or scene concepts
- Photographs or digital design work (e.g., graphics, digital drawing)
- Evidence of creative problem solving (e.g., ideas, rough sketches)
- Film work, research, or written work

We're not expecting professional-level work; we simply want to see your strengths and passion for film, design, and visual storytelling. Feel free to experiment – what matters most is expressing what you are truly passionate about.

We will send over a full schedule of the Applicant Day in advance, so keep an eye on your emails.

Next steps

Once you've attended an Applicant Day and completed your Portfolio Review, our Admissions Team will be in touch with the outcome.

If you receive an offer, you will need to apply via UCAS (or directly via our website, if you're an international applicant) if you have not already done so. Then, you can formally accept your offer.
