ONLINE AUDITION GUIDELINES

Congratulations on being offered an audition at Performers College! You may be feeling a mixture of excitement and nerves, but please don't worry - we're here to support you every step of the way. Our goal is to provide you with the best possible experience, helping you feel comfortable and confident so you can deliver your best performance.

The audition panel will assess your potential and suitability for the course, alongside your current abilities. They will also consider your passion for learning and ambition for a career in the performing arts industry.

Please read the following guidelines carefully.

Prepare and submit a video

Your audition video should include the following sections:

INTRODUCTION

In a brief spoken introduction to camera, please include:

- Your full name
- Where you are currently studying
- A summary of your experience so far
- Why you are interested in studying at Performers College
- Your career aspirations

PRACTICAL COMPONENTS

Please film the following:

- **Jazz Sequences:** Record basic stretches, kicks, pirouettes, and leaps.
- **Solo Dance:** This can be pre-recorded from a showcase or performance but should showcase your individuality, musicality, and strengths.
- **Solo Song:** Record a song that suits your vocal range and you are familiar with. The recording must be no longer than 3 minutes.
- **Acting Monologue:** Prepare and record a contemporary, age-appropriate monologue of approximately 1 minute and 30 seconds.

Note: Your monologue must not be from a film, musical, or Shakespeare play.

The panel will assess:

- Creativity and Imagination
- Connection and Commitment
- Applied Acting Technique
- Training Potential

How to submit your video:

- Audition videos must be submitted via YouTube.
- Create a playlist titled with your full name and date of birth, e.g. JohnSmith010191.
- Ensure all videos are set to 'unlisted' in sharing settings so that the playlist can be shared.
- If you're unsure how to upload to YouTube, there are many tutorials available online.
- Send your YouTube link to submissions@bimm.ac.uk.

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT

After submitting your audition video, we aim to email your audition outcome within two weeks. If successful and you applied via UCAS, your offer will appear on UCAS Hub and be sent to you via email. You must accept your offer on UCAS Hub before the UCAS deadline provided to you.

We look forward to watching your self-tape and wish you the best of luck with your audition!
