

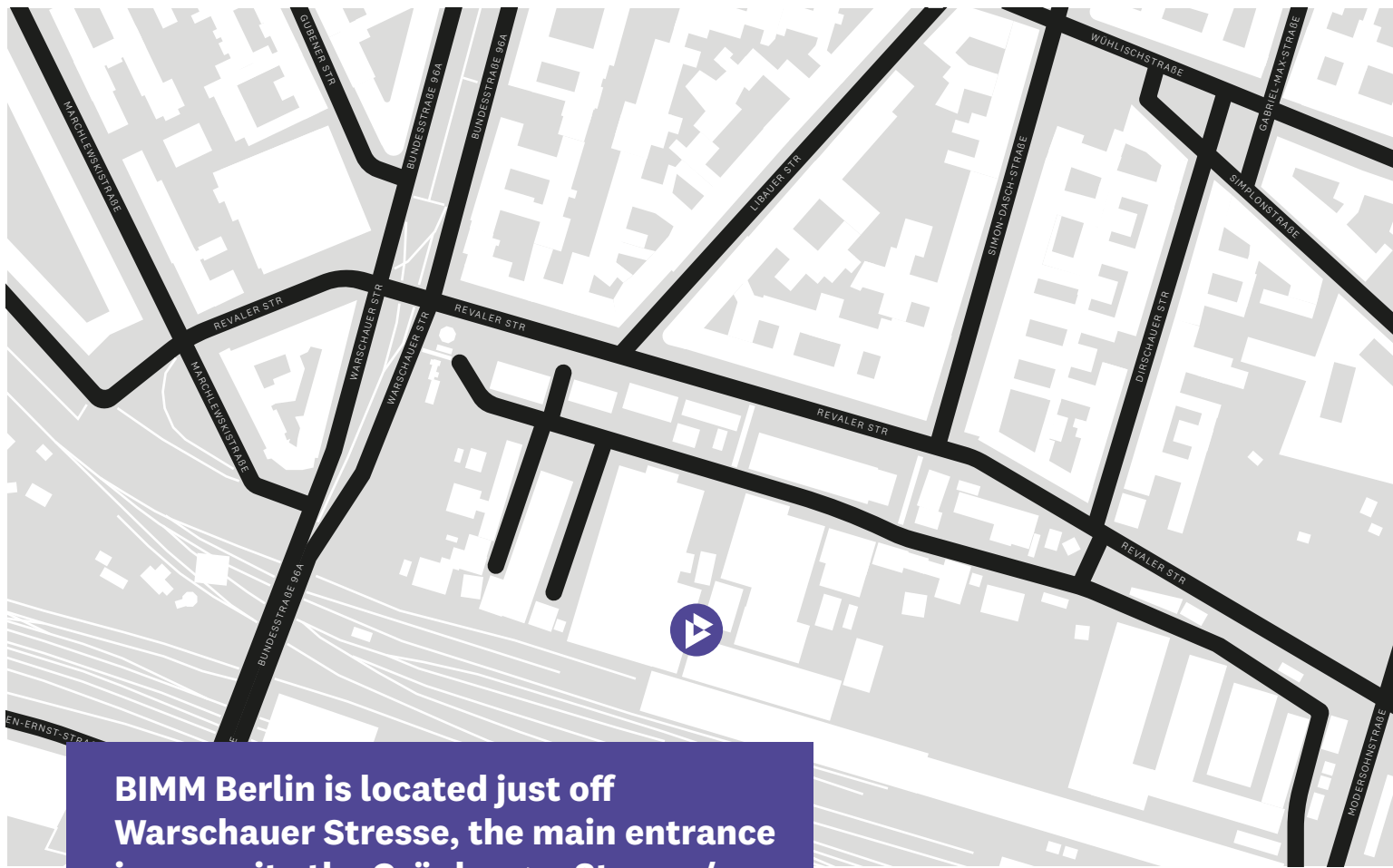

BIMM Berlin is located just off Warschauer Strasse, the main entrance is opposite the Grünberger Strasse/ Warschauer tram stop.

Getting Around

The institute's nearest U-Bahn station is Warschauer Str on the U1, closest stop 5 min walk.

The S-Bahn lines S3, S5, S7 and S75 from Alexanderplatz. The M10 and M13 trams stop very close to the institute, which is also served by the 240 and N40 bus routes. Parking is very limited within the area.

External Venues

Some lessons are taught off-site at external venues, however all can be easily reached by foot, bike or public transport

Privatclub

This live music venue is located within an impressive brick stone building on Skalitzer Str. 85-86 in Kreuzberg which used to serve and is still partially being used as a post office. Further information can be found here: www.privatclub-berlin.de It's in walking distance from the BIMM campus (or bike if you prefer) but is also served by the U1 line. Closest stops are Schlesisches Tor and Görlitzer Bahnhof.

Trixx Studios

Since 1985 Trixx Studios have been providing state-of-the-art recording and production facilities at their location on Prinzessinnenstraße 16 in Kreuzberg. You can read more about the studios, their equipment, clients and location here: www.trixx-studios.de/index_eng.html The studio complex is served by U1 and U8 lines equally. Closest stations are Moritzplatz (U8) and Prinzenstraße or Kottbusser Tor (U1).

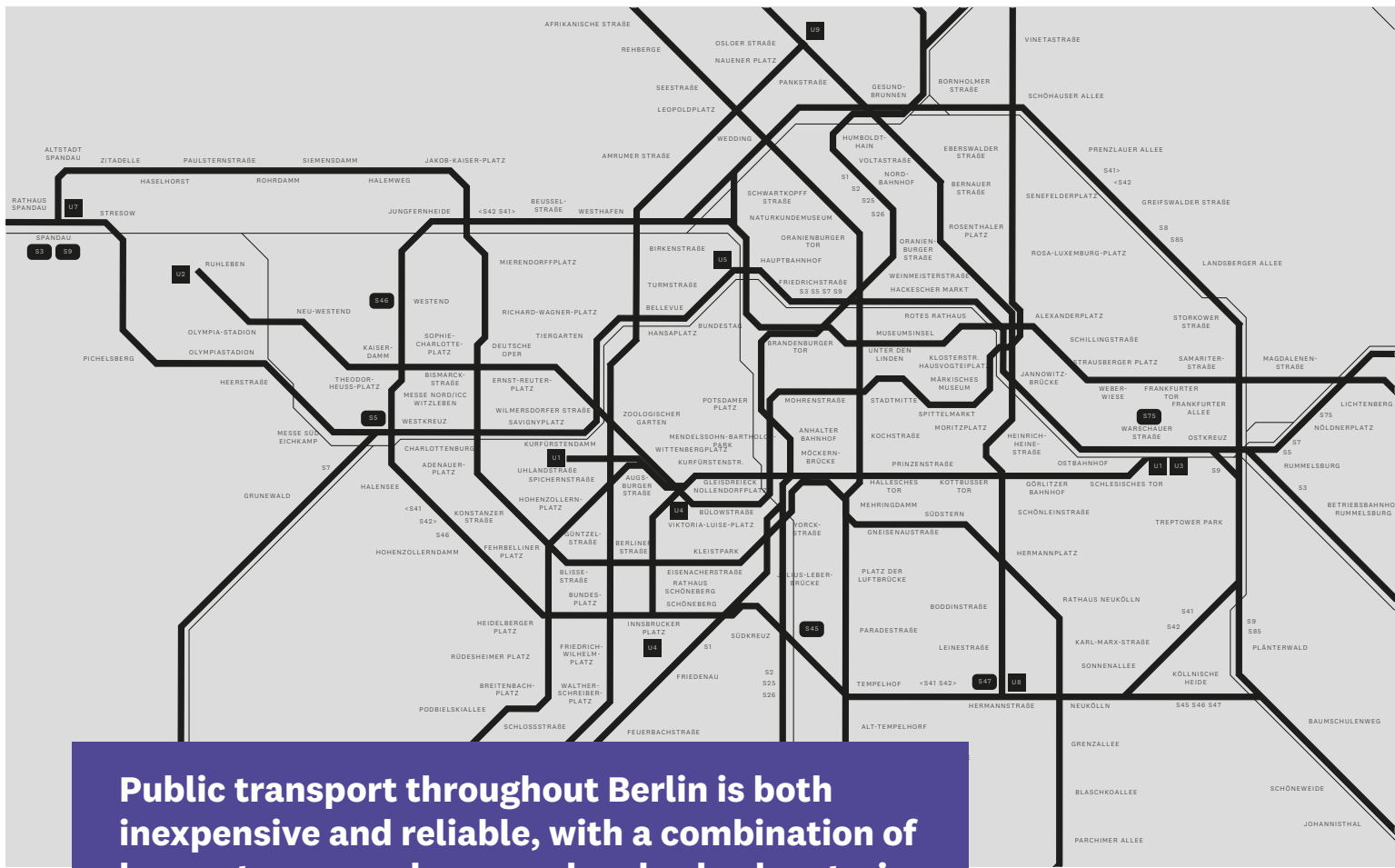
Warschauer 58

Located on Warschauer Straße at number 58, which is less than 5 minutes' walk away from the main BIMM Berlin building; this space is now the BIMM Berlin drum room and multipurpose teaching space. All of our drum lessons take place there as well as some other instrumental teaching. Just 5 minutes' walk away is the Warschauer Straße S-Bahn station where you can catch the S5, S7 and S75.

RAW 28

RAW is a collection of industrial buildings in central Berlin, situated right next to Warschauer Straße S-Bahn station. It is a buzzing area full of creatives and artists, as well as having clubs, bars and even a swimming pool.

RAW 28 is in the RAW grounds at 99 Revaler Straße. It is one of the first buildings on the right as you enter RAW from the Warschauer Straße entrance (down the steps). This is where a number of our lessons will take place in one of the two multipurpose rooms.



Public transport throughout Berlin is both inexpensive and reliable, with a combination of buses, trams, underground and suburban trains serving the metropolitan area.

The city is also extremely bicycle-friendly, with dedicated cycle paths and plenty of secure storage.

The map (above) shows S-Bahn and U-Bahn routes to BIMM Berlin from nearby areas. Major stations and local stations near to BIMM are shown. Tram & bus routes are not shown.
